I called and spoke with Mrs. regarding the allegations. She was not sure who the teacher was in the classroom when her son came home with soiled clothing and feces on his back. She said that she had pictures and was going to send them to me. She said that the teacher didn't find his blanket and actually left her in the classroom with the other children when she went to look for it. There was no other teacher in the class watching the kids. She was also upset that she had sent diapers and wipes to the daycare and they put the wrong diapers on him causing him to break out in a rash.

Explanation of Disposition:

Based on the information obtained, it is clear that a child was sent home from the operation with feces on the back of his pants. He was not cleaned and changed properly. The caregiver said she didn't notice that his pants were soiled. A photo of the pants shows that they were soiled heavily and would have been easy to see. The diapers are now all individually labeled and sippy cups are brought in by the parents but they are not individually labeled for the children as they are sanitized after each use.

The allegation of supervision is currently being investigated in a DFPS investigation. Multiple reports have been made alleging that staff are not staying in classrooms and leaving children unattended.
